DANCER(S) MUST PRESENT A VALID SCOTDANCE CARD. Any Beginner, Novice or Intermediate dancer that forgets their card, or is not in possession of their card for any reason (including during the application process) must pay a \$10 penalty and have any awards withheld until such time as the dancer presents their valid card.

PHOTOGRAPHY: By registering online, you agree to allow SDGHDA to use you/your dancer's photograph on our website and social media.

PLEASE NOTE: Registration is deemed complete only **AFTER** payment has been processed. To process payment, you will be required to submit a credit or debit card payment using PayPal. You are NOT required to have a PayPal account to complete a registration. COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS

Rules for attending ScotDance Canada Sanctioned Competitions:

1. All dancing events are governed by the rules and regulations of the Royal Scottish Official Board of Highland Dancing (RSOBHD) and ScotDance Canada.

2. This event may be cancelled at any time up to, and including on or during the date of competition, dependent upon public health concerns.
3. The decision of the judge(s) is final.
4. Dancers will compete in inverse order of entry. First to enter is last to dance.
5. Age is as of 12:01 AM on competition date.
6. Entry fee must accompany entry.
7. Late entries may only be accepted at the discretion of the Organizer. All late entries will be subject to an additional fee of \$20.
8. Refunds are at discretion of Competition Organizer policy. Where admittance to event is refused based upon good health declaration, fees will be refunded (excepting an administration fee of \$5.00 per family).
9. Dancers must be registered with the RSOBHD or RSOBHD subsidiary body (such as ScotDance Canada) in order to compete.
10. All competitors must present current RSOBHD registration card prior to receiving awards.
11. Protests must be made in writing, signed and submitted to the Organizer by the end of the competition day and must be accompanied by a \$35.00 fee, refundable, if sustained.
12. The Organizer reserves the right to combine or split classes.
13. No category changes will be accepted on the day of competition.
14. Competitors must be on hand when their event is called or forfeit entry in that dance.
15. All competitors must remain in costume for award presentations.
16. Dancers must be dressed appropriately at all times.

SDGHDA will not be responsible for loss of property or injury no matter how caused.

If dancer changes category before date of competition, please email registrar@sdghda.ca ahead of time in order to make proper changes.

Any dancer who decides not to compete after having registered should notify registrar@sdghda.ca in advance of the event.

As per the ScotDance Canada "Child and Youth Abuse Prevention Program" policy, dancers will not be permitted to change in public areas, nor will dancers be permitted to be in the competition area only wearing bra tops or sports bras with dickies. Dancers must wear their jackets/vests, hoodies, studio jackets or tank tops over any bra-type top used for dancing whenever they are outside the designated change area. We ask all dancers and parents for their cooperation in this regard and to please use the designated change areas when changing.

AWARDS:

- All Categories – Medals to be awarded to 6 places. Overall and runner-up keeper trophies shall be awarded in each age group.
- In the event of a tie for Overall, no Runner-up shall be awarded if an age group has six or less dancers. If the group has more than six dancers, in the event of a tie for Overall, a Runner-up shall also be awarded.
- Prize money will be awarded to the Premier dancers 16 and over to a maximum of two paying groups. Cash awards will be as follows: junior paying group 1st – \$30 2nd – \$25 3rd - \$20 4th- 15 5th - \$10 6th - \$10 and senior paying group 1st – \$35 2nd – \$30 3rd - \$25 4th- \$20 5th - \$15 6th - \$15.
- Aggregate perpetual trophies shall be awarded in each category; Overall Beginner, Overall Novice, Overall Intermediate, Overall Junior Premier (under 16 years), Overall Senior Premier (16 years and over), and Premier Dancer-of-the-Day.
- Age groups will be formed at the discretion of the Competition Organizing Committee.
- Dancers will dance in reverse order of receipt of entries.

- Per RSOBHD rules, Beginner dancers will only have their dance cards stamped for 1st, 2nd or 3rd placings in any of the 4 Highland dances (Fling, Sword, Seann Triubhas, Reel), but placings in national dances will count towards an overall aggregate award. Novice dancers will have their card stamped at every competition where they win a 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any dance.
